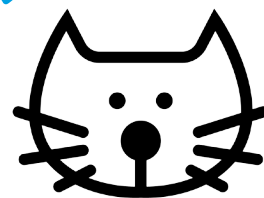


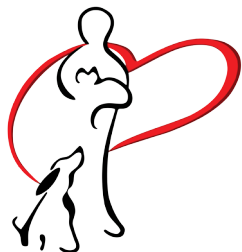

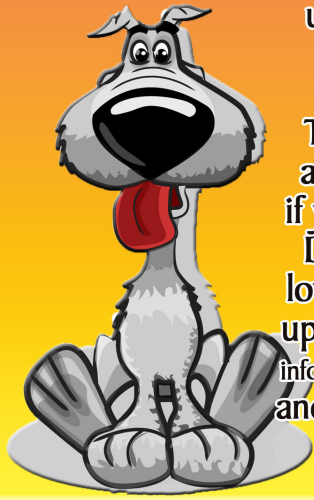

Volunteer Voice

Always a "Fur"ever Home

Once upon a time we lived with a beautiful cat named Memphis. I met him at a shelter and got him out immediately because he was gorgeous. He was a Snowshoe, an uncommon breed of cat who looks like a Siamese with white boots and white patches.

He laid on my lap, paws up and I laughed because he was so trusting. When my husband and I adopted him, we got him home and let him out of the carrier. Right away and he began running up and down the stairs fast. He seemed like a maniac and I feared we'd made a mistake. So we took him out to our studio (a former garage we use as our workshop) and there he cooed and bumped heads with Earl Grey, our sweet grey cat. Next he greeted our cats Joplin and Sampson easily. It was like they were all waiting for him to join our family. We figured that Memphis had never seen stairs before, perhaps he had lived in an apartment his whole life before coming to our home.

He blended in with our three cats gracefully and my husband and I found a great joy in our life. Some of our cats passed away and we added others, but Memphis was always the same. He had equanimity with all cats and accepted every cat as they were. No matter what sadness or anxiety beset us, our friend Memphis, who we nicknamed Fudge, gave us comfort and happiness.

He lived a good long life, yet he developed diabetes and eventually renal failure. Our vet taught my husband to give him the subcutaneous fluids that he needed every other day, and his quality of life was still very good, but the time came when he had to go to heaven (two days after Thanksgiving).

I volunteered with heavy sorrow the next Monday. I love cats, so volunteering is good for my soul. The last cat I met that day was named Mumu and she was a perfectly pretty dilute calico. I sat down and she put her head on my shoulder and paw on my heart. I started crying...I needed to cry.

We adopted her a week later, and I picked her up by myself. On the ½ hour drive home she hollered louder and louder and then started hitting the cage door with all her force. I was upset, crying, thinking I'd rushed to get a new cat after such a profound loss. At home, I opened the cage to her room. She strolled over to me, jumped on my lap, put her paw in my heart and laid her head on my shoulder. I said "we're home."

We named her Mercy. She was probably named Mumu at the shelter because instead of hissing she mooed. We laughed so hard the first time our big black cat, Thursday, got too close to her. "Moo" she said, and he jumped back looking puzzled.

Two years have passed since she came to us. As we had to deal with the latest shock of losing our magical cat, Prince Kafka, to cancer Mercy is our anchor. She misses her brother too, but her generous affection is helping us. We hope to find another cat to fill Kafka's shoes. Each cat gives us endless stories to fill our imagination and becomes an angel to us.

3 Days

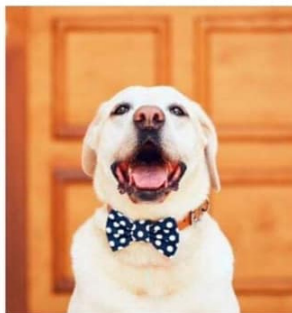
Your new dog is trying to figure out their new home & family
