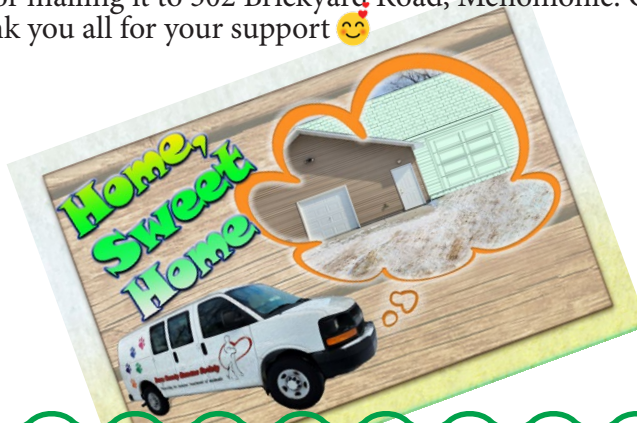

What exactly is a “contracted township?”

Wow, another year is officially in the books and 2023 is off to a great start! In looking back on 2022 I found that I was getting one question regularly - What does it mean when a municipality contracts with us? When a municipality contracts with us, any stray dog or cat found in that municipality by a member of the public or law enforcement can be immediately brought to us free of charge (if it has been an extended period of time that the animal has been cared for, it is no longer considered a stray).

When a stray animal comes to the Dunn County Humane Society, we not only take care of basic food and shelter for them but we also provide for any necessary medical care while we locate its owners or find its forever home. When they are healthy and old enough this includes spaying and neutering those in our care before they go to their forever homes.

Below is a list of our currently contracted municipalities. If a stray is found in a township that is not listed below, the finder will need to contact their town chair to find out what the procedure is for strays.

Sometimes we are having so much fun that we don't realize that we are dehydrated or have had too much sun, so it is important (for us and our pets) to take occasional breaks from what we are doing and drink plenty of water.

Sweat is how our bodies work at keeping us cool, but our pets do not have this ability. Overheating in a dog or cat may be simply panting or drooling, but it can be as severe as confusion, weakness or even seizures.



If your pet exhibits any of these severe symptoms, please call your vet immediately.
